Makenzie was born in February 2016 with Recessive Dystrophic Epidermolysis Bullosa (RDEB). Her disease is a rare genetic mutation that causes her body to not produce collagen, which is literally the “glue” that holds our skin layers together. Makenzie was born without skin on her hands and feet, and continues to blister and slough her fragile skin daily. She undergoes several hours of bandage changes to lance her blisters and treat her wounds. Makenzie’s mom and dad used socks to hold her bandages on during the first 7 months of her life. Makenzie still uses socks as her retention bandage on her feet. We “ROCK OUR SOCKS” to support Makenzie and other individuals with EB. There is NO CURE for EB! It is known as “THE WORST DISEASE YOU NEVER HEARD OF!” Wound care and pain management are the traditional treatment approaches for EB. The Cadmus Family is fighting to give Makenzie an experimental bone marrow transplant pioneered at The University of Minnesota, which will allow her brother Crosby’s healthy cells to be introduced to her body, allowing Makenzie to produce collagen and improve her skin integrity, quality and length of life.
