Old Fashioned Farm Fun: Recreate farm life from the 1800s as you dip candles, churn butter, master tinsmithing, and learn about all of the essential farm animals from then and now.

Tuesday, February 20 - Choose one!

Minecraft Mania: Minecraft – minus the screen - will come to life with STEM activities from planting, crafting, and brewing to spawning and creating portals. Protect our farm from creepers and nocturnal spiders! Relate Minecraft to real world agriculture, animal husbandry, and science.

Move & Groove: Enjoy a day of music and movement! Greet the day with morning yoga, jam out in our drum circle, participate in multicultural activities and dances, and perform for our resident farm animals. All musical, yoga, and dance levels are welcome.

Wednesday, February 21 - Choose one!

Kitchen Creations: Get creative by making tasty and healthy treats! Visit our cows and chickens to learn how we get ingredients we need like milk and eggs. Bake cookies by learning to follow a recipe. Then compete in an Iron Chef-like challenge using secret, savory ingredients. Learn how to make nutritious snacks for you and your friends!

Fire and Ice: Explore the winter wonderland the farm has become. Paint snow, make frozen bubbles and create ice sculptures! No snow? No problem! You'll discover ways to make your own. While we're having fun outside, you'll learn what farm animals and wildlife do in the winter. Then we'll warm up by the campfire with a tasty treat!
