# MINUTES ROCKY POINT PUBLIC SCHOOLS BOARD OF EDUCATION MEETING APRIL 21, 2010

#### Mr. Nofi called the meeting to order at 7:42 P.M.

Mr. Nofi opened the floor to questions and/or comments from meeting attendees.

• Mr. Thomas Reilly provided an update with reference to his request that the district provide a smaller bus to accommodate the children in the cul de sac in which he and his family reside. Mr. Reilly asked the members of the Board to consider the adoption of a policy permitting the use of smaller-sized buses in areas in which larger busses posed significant safety concerns. Mr. Reilly thanked Dr. Ring for his tireless efforts in working towards an acceptable solution to this ongoing safety concern. Mr. Nofi acknowledged Dr. Ring's efforts and stated it was the intention of the Board to act in the best interests of the families and children of the district. Mr. Nofi advised that there were several challenges to overcome in order to resolve the situation, including the reopening of the contract with the bus company. Mr. Nofi expressed his appreciation to Mr. and Mrs. Reilly for their patience and advised that the Board would do everything in its power to rectify the situation safely.
